Please note that Catholic Cemeteries does not inter on the following holidays: NEW YEARS DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, JULY 5th, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY. There will be no interments on Sundays. The following holidays will be charged a "Saturday fee": President's Day, Good Friday, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, and Friday after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and New Year's Eve, 2010

OTHER CHARGES

Vault Handling: This is included in our interment/vault handling service fee. If a family has already made pre-need arrangements with Catholic Cemeteries prior to September 1, 2000, the vault handling fee will be charged at the time of need. This vault handling fee is as follows:

\$350.00 weekdays before 1 pm; \$400.00 weekdays between 1 pm and 3 pm; \$500.00 weekdays 3-4pm (daylight savings time only) \$100.00 additional per hour 4 pm and later; \$400.00 Saturdays before noon; \$500.00 Saturdays noon until 3pm; \$600.00 3-4pm Saturdays (daylight savings time only); \$100.00 additional charge every hour 4pm and later. Our vault handling includes: tent or chapel use, chairs, and vault setup.

ACCOMMODATION FEES	
<p>When cremated remains or infants are interred as a second burial in a grave, the cemetery must be contacted before final arrangements are made with the family. Not all graves can accommodate cremated remains buried on top of the existing burial vault. Cremated remains may also be placed in an occupied crypt in the mausoleum. An accommodation fee is charged for all second burials on the same grave or in the same crypt. These charges are:</p>	
Adult cremated remains accommodation fee	500.00
Infant cherub entombed with adult in mausoleum	300.00

The mausoleum chapel is available for all funerals at Catholic Cemeteries. However, for our planning we need to know at least 24 hours ahead if you wish to use the chapel for a ground burial interment service. If we are not informed ahead of time, we will bill the Funeral Home a \$75.00 service fee charge. When the chapel service is chosen, we require that the funeral end there. There will be no tent, no above-ground vault setup, no snow removal, and no chairs set up at graveside. The cemetery or the funeral home can transport the casket after the family and friends have left.

Each body buried in Catholic Cemeteries requires an outer burial container, including cremated remains. Catholic Cemeteries oversees all vault handling. If a special request is made for a specific vault company to do the setup, our charges still apply.

All fees are due before the burial, unless prior arrangements have been approved by the cemetery.

Adult disinterment (removal) charges will be quoted upon request. Opening of the casket in the cemetery is prohibited. The cemetery authorities shall exercise due care in making a disinterment or removal, but shall assume no liability for damage to any casket or outer container incurred in making the disinterment or removal. No disentombment shall be allowed from mausoleum abbey crypts.

Cremated remains may not be placed on the top of an existing interment as we require 18" of earth over all interments and this requirement could not be met. Two cremation vaults may be placed in one adult grave space, but only one marker is permitted.

All pre-paid interment, entombment and inurnment charges will be honored for weekday burials before 1 pm. After 1 pm weekdays, and all day on Saturdays are considered as "exceptions", and the following additional charges apply:
